Tepel Brothers In Growth Mode (12/09/2005)

Commercial printer Tepel Brothers, Troy, MI, has doubled its staff to 42 and expects sales to increase \$7.5 million to \$18 million in 2005. The company also spent \$5 million on a 17,000-sq.ft. facility expansion, bringing its total plant size to 50,000 sq.ft.

Tepel Brothers produces a wide range of projects, from simple brochures printed in one color to catalogs, calendars and posters printed in six colors.

The expansion will accommodate new equipment and improve workflow. The company added a 40" Heidelberg Speedmaster CD 102.

"We are the most diverse printer in Southeast Michigan when it comes to equipment," says Jim Tepel, president. "We can price the job on the right piece of equipment every single time, whether it's printing one or one million pieces."

The privately held company projects 2006 sales of \$23 million.
